Health and safety Update

We now have a number of children in school with severe allergies to nuts and other foods. In order to keep all children safe I have taken the decision that Woodgrange will be a nut free school. Please do not include nuts in any form if you provide your child with a packed lunch, including on educational visits. The staff will also not be bringing nuts into school.

Sweet treats and birthdays

This may be my most unpopular decision ever but in order to

- avoid any nuts or dairy foods etc being accidentally given to children with allergies
- ensure children receive consistently clear messages about healthy eating
- avoid parents feeling under pressure to spend

We will no longer accept ANY birthday sweets/ treats etc including party bags.

From Monday 16th September staff will turn away any offerings. We will of course sing Happy Birthday and make a child feel special but will leave any other celebrations for you to organise out of school.
