Dear Families,

We welcome Anjum Vahora to our Governing Board as a parent governor. She is a parent of a child in Lime Class.

We have successfully gifted the donated clothes and toys. Thank you so much for your generosity. Next week we will issue vouchers for children entitled to benefits related free school meals. We will also be able to help some more families using funds donated to the helping hands fund.

School is open and obviously the children are playing and learning together in school. There are however still restrictions in place out in the wider world. We are following careful rules in school and avoiding any sort of mixing beyond classes and really need your support outside of school.

Currently the covid restrictions are as follows:

People are allowed to leave home for recreation and exercise outdoors with their household or support bubble, if they are eligible for one, or with one person from outside their household.

From 29th March outdoor gatherings (including in private gardens) of either 6 people (the Rule of 6) or 2 households will also be allowed, making it easier for friends and families to meet outside.

Indoor play dates and sleepovers etc are still not allowed for some time to come. It's about keeping numbers of contacts low to keep risks low.

Numbers of cases have dropped locally but have levelled out in recent weeks. We haven't had to close any bubbles so far but have had staff absent due to self-isolation... it is still with us!

Over the holidays I will be "on call" in case of positive test results over the Easter weekend. After Sunday any symptoms will not require action on the part of school.
