We will do all we can to support this effort, including:

- SENDING HOME LIBRARY BOOKS TO ENJOY
- SIGNING ALL CHILDREN UP TO THE LOCAL LIBRARY AND VISITING WITH THEM
- PROMOTING LOCAL LIBRARY EVENTS SUCH AS READING CHALLENGES
- SENDING HOME BOOKS CHILDREN CAN PRACTISE READING TO THEIR FAMILY
- PROVIDE ALL CHILDREN IN RECEPTION, YEAR 1 AND YEAR 2 WITH ACCESS TO AN ONLINE READING PLATFORM THAT IS LINKED TO OUR PHONICS PROGRAMME
- OFFERING SUPPORT AND GUIDANCE TO PARENTS, EITHER THROUGH WORKSHOPS OR INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS ON DEMAND
